Attached to this letter are two items:

- 1. A virement form. If you have not already done so please complete this and pay your subscription for 2013.
- 2. A list of members with their commune of residence. This is an extract from the entry in the Register of Commerce which the Society is obliged to submit and which is available publicly. As mentioned in our circular e-mail of 13 January in accordance with Luxembourg law a list of members with their nationality and postal addresses is submitted to the Registre de Commerce. We advised then that we were proposing to circulate to members a list of our members together with postal addresses. Members were asked to advise if they objected to this. While there was no significant objection the Committee decided to limit the address to the name of the commune of residence. 2012 was brought to a close with our now well established appearance at the Foire de l'Etudiant and a highly efficient programme of practice interviews conducted together with the Cambridge Society. Andrew Hallan orchestrated events for the Society and we were honoured by the visit from the Senior Tutor and Tutor for Admissions at Brasenose who attended our stand at the Foire and visited a number of schools.

Andrew and his team provided interview practice for 37 aspiring Oxonians and Cantabrians. Sadly they were much less successful than last year with 3 offers from Oxford (5 in 2011) and only one from Cambridge (3 in 2011).

While on the subject I should mention that we (Oxford and Cambridge Societies) will be holding another joint information event on 11th April and they will be looking for mentors to talk to students on their subject areas (contact secrtry@oxford.lu)

After an excellent 2012 with record membership your Society has got off to a quick start in 2013 with an event-packed year in prospect. The **joint dinner with the Oxford Belgo-Luxembourgish Society at University College** is reported on our website www.oxford.lu. This was followed by **Brief Lives with Music** concerts held at the Seymours' house on 23rd and 24th February, based on readings from Aubrey's "Brief Lives". The concerts raised €500 euros net, which the Seymours have generously donated to OUSL for use by needy Luxembourg students at Oxford, Aubrey's old university.

We have since then had a fascinating talk by Laurent Mignon, a Luxembourger and University Lecturer in Turkish and a Fellow of Saint Antony's College, Oxford on the reception of Rabindranath Tagore in Turkey and a very enjoyable social dinner with our friends from the Cambridge Society.

<u>Friday, 28 - Sunday, 30 June 2013: Oxford and Cambridge Benelux reunion in Luxembourg and Annual Dinner</u>

The Society is inviting members of Oxford and Cambridge Societies in Belgium and the Netherlands to a reunion weekend in Luxembourg which shall take place on 28-30 June 2013. The provisional programme is as follows:

Friday, 28 June:

On Friday evening we will organise a "**pub crawl**" through some of Luxembourg's best known cafés and clubs in the picturesque "Grund" area and the "Rives de Clausen".

For those of a less lively disposition we will arrange a table or two at a typical and charming Luxembourgish restaurant in the city.

Saturday, 29 June:

Reunion of the Benelux alumni in the morning to get to know each other.

- Alternative tours have been arranged thanks to OUSL members as follows: City Museum & Archives or The old City.
- Lunch will be arranged in a City centre restaurant.
- After lunch we visit the European Investment Bank art collection.
- In the evening we will organise a concert entitled "SONNETS TO SUNDRY NOTES OF MUSIC" with
- British countertenor Christopher Robson who is also a "Kammersänger" (German honorific title for distinguished singers) in Bavaria.
- Robson and a lute player will perform his Shakespeare and John Donne Sonnets programme (see www.oxford.lu/events for a programme that he did at the Teamtheater in Munich a few years ago). The concert will take place in the church of St. Jean-du-Grund.
- There will be a collection in favour of the Luxembourg branch of "SOS Villages d'enfants" (https://www.sosve.lu/). This Charity, whose patron is HRH Grand-Duchess Maria-Teresa, provides shelter, medical care and education for over 80.000 children in more than 133 countries.
- The concert will be followed by a black tie (or lounge suit) dinner at the "Cercle Munster". The guest of honour and speaker will be HE The Hon Alice Walpole (MA Cantab), Her Britannic Majesty's Ambassador in Luxembourg.

Sunday, 30 June:

- A visit to Luxembourg's fortress museum (Musee Drai Eechelen) and national identity exhibition. Further information can be found in the 2013 Luxembourg City brochure (attached) and on http://llux.uni.lu.
- For those staying a little bit longer, OUSL members will be happy to show them around further parts of the city including The European Quarter (depending on numbers).
